## Conference venue

The Outreach Centre is located within what is referred to as the Holyrood Campus of the University of Edinburgh which is well served by public transport. ## Getting there

**Arriving by train (Edinburgh Waverley)** The Outreach Centre is approximately 10 minutes' walk from Waverley Station in the city centre. Exiting via Calton Road entrance/exit – Turn right onto New Street, turn right onto the Canongate/Royal Mile, turn left onto Gullan's Close, turn right to stay on Gullan's Close and then turn right onto Holyrood Road.

Exiting via Market Street entrance/exit – Turn left onto Market Street then turn right onto Jeffrey Street and continue onto St Mary's Street. Turn left onto Holyrood Road then turn left onto Morgan Lane.

**Arriving by Bus** Buses and coaches arrive at St Andrews Square Bus Station in Edinburgh's City Centre. Bus stops nearest the venue are on High Street and the Cowgate. Numerous bus services stop on these streets.

**Parking** Parking in Edinburgh is restricted and can be expensive. There is an NCP Car Park opposite the venue at Viewcraig Gardens. If you take your paper ticket to be validated at the Reception Desk at Paterson's Land you will receive the discounted rate of £6.40 for the day. More information available by clicking on this link:
